Dear student,

Riding your bicycle through Maastricht is lovely. No mode of transportation takes you through the city center faster than a bike. Throughout the center of Maastricht, you come across many bicycle racks and spots, easy to find thanks to the green signs.

Keep it #posifiets!

To keep it as #posifiets as possible, there are a few rules. For example, about parking your bicycle on the pavement. This is how you keep it fun for other cyclists, pedestrians and everyone with whom you share the sidewalk and the city.



Some rules and regulations to avoid fines:

The general municipal bylaw of the Municipality of Maastricht lists rules to prevent nuisance from bicycles. For instance, in Maastricht it is forbidden to park your bicycle outside the bicycle-parking facilities in the central shopping district, Wyck and the train station area. In the rest of the city, you are permitted to park your bicycle outside the bicycle-parking facilities. But please take note... parking your bicycle in an inconvenient manner is banned everywhere in the city.

There is a maximum parking time of 2 consecutive weeks in a parking facility in the city centre and Wyck. If you leave your bicycle or moped there for a longer period, it can be removed by the municipality and taken to the bike depot on Gerardusweg 39. Collecting your bicycle costs €25.

The Enforcement Team of the Municipality of Maastricht monitors compliance with these rules. Enforcement officers talk to cyclists and label bicycles that are parked incorrectly. The label shows how long you have to correctly park your bike. If you do not do this within the set time, your bike will be removed and put into storage in the bike depot.
