Bicycle-parking facilities

Sticking around town for a while?

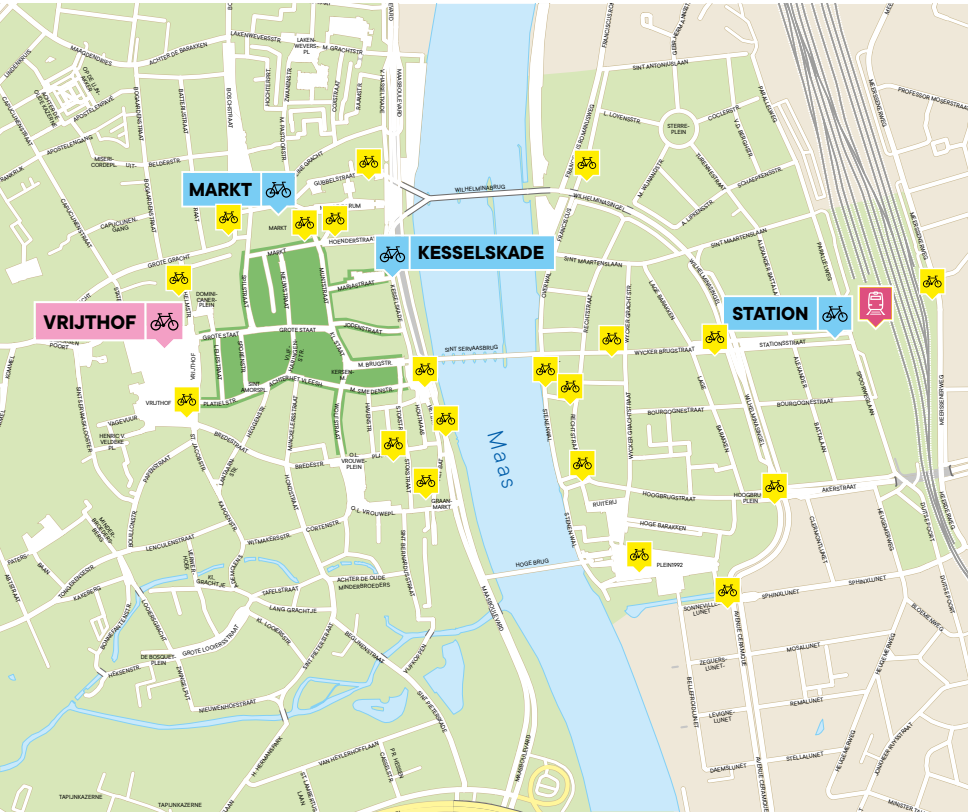
Park your bike at one of the gateways to the city centre. Free and with (camera) surveillance: Kesselskade - Markt - Vrijthof - Central Station (first 24 hours free).

Not staying too long?

Park your bike at one of the dedicated racks, facilities, or zones.

If a parking facility is full...

Follow the green bike signs to find the nearest alternative.



Staying longer in town?
Covered bicycle-parking facilities with surveillance

Staying longer in town?
Covered bicycle-parking facilities without surveillance

Just popping in?
Bicycle racks or zones without surveillance

City centre (area in green) max. two weeks: bicycle rack, facility, or zone.

Central shopping cluster (area in dark green); please dismount here when shops are open.

All bike spots taken? You can still be #posifiets

- Think of others when parking:
- Leave 1 metre of space from the kerb — so sidewalks stay accessible for everyone
- Always lock your bike safely
- Keep emergency exits and stairwells clear

Combining public transport and cycling

Maastricht can easily be reached by public transport from any location in the Euregio Meuse-Rhine. As an EU-student in the Netherlands, you have the option to travel to and from your educational institution free of charge or at a discounted rate when utilizing public transportation. For additional information, please visit duo.nl.

Switching between public transport and the bike

If you wish to seamlessly switch between public transport and cycling, Maastricht offers two bicycle-sharing systems:

- Public transport bicycles (OV-fiets) are available for rent at Maastricht railway station for a nominal daily fee. Further details can be found at ns.nl/en/door-to-door/ov-fiets.
- The glimble and/or Arriva Deelfiets app to access the shared bicycle system can also be used to access the Arriva Shared Bicycle system. Users should pay for the duration of their bicycle use. For more information, please visit glimble.nl/en

Travelling by P+R Noord

Alternatively, if you choose to travel with a car, you can park for free at P+R Noord, located in the suburbs of Maastricht. From there, you can continue your journey to the city center by bus. Arriva's bus line 3, 10 and 30 operate every 15 minutes and cost only € 2.45 per person for a round trip to and from the heart of the city.



Student Mobility Card



International students get 20-40% discount on bus and train journeys with Arriva through a Student Mobility Card.



Park your car free of charge and Arriva's bus line 3, 10 and 30 will take you every 15 minutes for only € 2.45 p.p. to the heart of the city and back again.

How to get a bike?



We recommend one of the first things you do after arriving in Maastricht is buying a bike. Before your purchase, it is good to

consider a couple of things, such as, your budget, how often you need your bike and where you can store it. You can visit one of the many bike shops to buy a new or second-hand bicycle.

Is your bicycle missing?

Your bicycle may have been removed by the municipality if it was parked incorrectly.



Scan the QR code to check whether it has been taken to the Bike Depot. If your bike is listed, you can collect it at the Bike Depot

(Gerardusweg 39) on Monday between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM, after paying a €50 fine.

If your bike is not at the depot, it may have been stolen. In that case, please report it to the police by calling +31 34 357 8844.
